WARNINGS TOW BALL BIKE RACKS



Please read the instructions carefully. The user is responsible for assembly and installation of this product.

Depending on the shape of your bicycle, BuzzRack cannot guarantee that it will fit properly on this carrier. You might have to use the BUZZGRIP for bicycle without top bar.

- 1. Fits 50mm tow balls. Always check the weight limitation of your towing system and never overload it.
- 2. Do not exceed the maximum bike carrying capacity of this bike carrier. Max 33 lb [15 kg] per hike
- 3. The user is responsible for periodically verifying that all hardware, straps, etc. are securely tightened for safety purposes.
- 4. This bike carrier must be assembled and installed in accordance with the instructions.
- 5. Check before departure that the light board of the carrier is properly functioning.
- 6. Verify that the bike wheels are not too close to the vehicle's exhaust system in order to avoid damage to the wheels.
- 7. The bike carrier and bikes will increase the overall dimensions of the vehicle. Be very careful when travelling in reverse.
- 8. The cargo will affect your driving behavior. Do not exceed the speed limit, and do not drive faster than 75 mph (120 km/h). Drive slowly over speed bumps. Off-road driving is not recommended when using this product. Respect the speed limit, and adapt your speed to the condition of the road.
- 9. If you hit a bump or a hole in the road, stop your vehicle and inspect the bikes and the carrier. If you notice anything wrong, remove the bikes and do not use the bike carrier.
- 10. Speed should always be adapted to safety considerations, taking into account traffic conditions and the load being carried.
- 11. Remove the bike carrier before entering an automatic car wash.
- 12. Do not modify any components of the bike carrier.
- 13. If your vehicle is equipped with an automatic tailgate opener, disable this function when using the bike carrier, and open the tailgate manually.
- 14. If the bikes and/or the carrier obstruct the vehicle's tail lights and license plate, you must use an additional signal board.
- 15. Do not use the bike carrier if you notice any damaged parts. Contact the dealer.
- 16. Failure to properly install this bike carrier and/or the bikes may cause damage to the vehicle and/or the bikes, and may result in personal injury.
- 17. Do not use this bike carrier for purposes other than those for which it is designed. Do not use for tandem bikes.
- 18. Verify that all parts are firmly tightened and attached before leaving and at every stop.
- 19. Periodically inspect the bike carrier for signs of wear, corrosion, and fatigue, and verify that the load is firmly attached.
- 20. Consult the dealer if you have any questions concerning this product.
- 21. Lubricate the bolts in order to avoid corrosion.
- 22. Do not install this bike carrier on a trailer or other towed vehicle.
- 23. Always keep the instructions.
